

Information about **William & Susanna WHITE**

William White was baptized at Wisbech, Cambridgeshire, England 25 Jan. 1586/87 and resided there until 1608.

By May 1608 William established residence at Amsterdam, Holland and joined the Ancient Brethren Church (an English Separatist Church).

About 1615 William married Susanna Jackson, the daughter of Richard Jackson of Scrooby, Nottinghamshire, England, probably in Amsterdam.

On Nov. 11 1620 William White signed the Mayflower Compact.

William White died the first winter at Plymouth 1620/21. [Prince p.184].

In Plymouth 12 May 1621 Susanna (Jackson) White married Mayflower Passenger Edward Winslow—the first marriage in Plymouth [Bradford pg.86].

In 1623 Plymouth Division of land William White family received 5 acres of land. [Plymouth County Records 12:4]

1627 Plymouth Division of Cattle; Resolved and Peregrine White were in the third company [PCR 12:10]

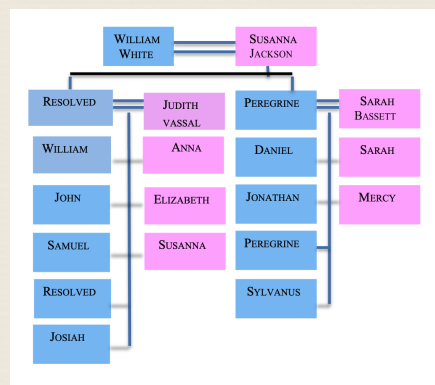
In 1636 Edward Winslow moved his family to Marshfield becoming one of its early founders.
