GENEALOGY

William WHITE bpt. 25 January 1586/7

Married about 1615 **Susanna JACKSON** born about 1594, daughter of Richard & Mary (Pettinger) Jackson of Scrooby, Nottinghamshire, England.

William died at Plymouth 25 Jan. 1620/21. Burial probably Cole's Hill. Susanna (Jackson) White Winslow died probably Marshfield, by 18 December 1654. Burial unknown.

CHILDREN:

- 1) **Resolved WHITE** b. About 1615 probably at Amsterdam. Married (1) Judith Vassall; married (2) Abigail (___) Lord, widow of William Lord. 5 October 1635 at Salem. Died prob. Marshfield after 19 September 1687.

- 2) **Peregrine WHITE** b. at Cape Cod Harbor [Provincetown, MA] on board the *Mayflower* between 27-30 November, 1620 Married prob. Marshfield pre 6 March 1648/9 Sara Bassett, daughter of William & Elisabeth Bassett 1611. Peregrine died at Marshfield, 20 July 1704. Burial probably at Winslow Cemetery.

William White was the uncle of Dorothy (May) **BRADFORD**, first wife of **WILLIAM BRADFORD**

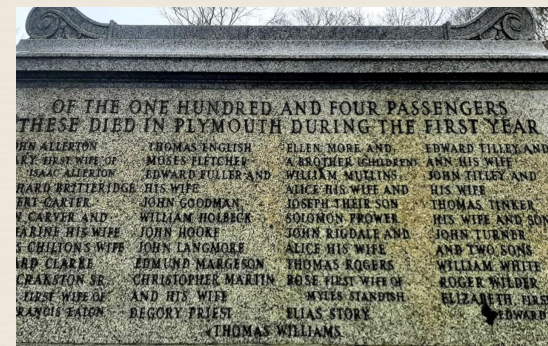

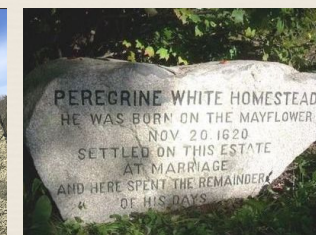
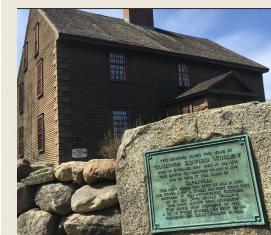
